Dear Residents,

You can see from the events listed below and on the back page that we have a number of upcoming events planned for you all to enjoy and get involved in.

We start in August and September with our two tree planting days. I am please to announce that this year we have partnered with Mirvac and HBF to plant approx 30,000 seedlings along the Foreshore Reserve. Across the bridge from Cupania Court is our first planting followed in September with the planting of 10,000 seedlings along the Aquarian Drive side of the brook. This area will look sensation when it is planted out and I encourage all of you to take an active interest in the planting and also the future upkeep of the area.

The dog walk, open day and the carols in the park were very well attended last year and we are looking forward to attracting more residents to enjoy the festivities this year. If you are willing to assist with the function on the day please let me know. We cannot put the events on without assistance and a little help goes a long way.

Over the past few month we have facilitated through the City of Swan the verge tree planting along Aquarian Drive, with addition planting planned for Talbot Road and Dongara Circle shortly. The association has organised for traffic bollards to be replaced, lights fixed, signs replaced and the path at the end of Viveash Road to be fixed along with other maintenance items within the suburb which needed actioning.

As I have said many times before it is important that we all take an active interest in our suburb and this can be as simple as putting forward an idea or letting us know if something within the area you live needs to be attended to.

By working together we can continue to work towards making Jane Brook the best suburb to live in possible.

Construction Update:

So much has happened in Jane Brook over the past year since the Highland Reserve community was launched – 78 homesites have been released in this exciting new community offering homebuyers a choice of size, location and views. Construction of the homesites in the Drovers Release (stage 1) has been completed along with stunning public artworks comprising of a 15m sundial, a collection of kangaroo sculptures and a viewing deck. Construction on stage 2 (Chichester Release) in Highland Reserve is progressing well, meaning homebuyers can move into their dream home even sooner. With the recent interest rate reduction and construction in the Chichester release due for completion in October 2012, now is the time to visit Highland Reserve. On other exciting news, the parklands and lake adjacent to Augustus Drive in the Chichester release will be finished and ready for use in spring! A community day is currently being planned with the Jane Brook Community Association to celebrate the opening of the park. This event will be advertised closer to the date.
