Dear Residents,

I am pleased to announce that since our last communication we have been awarded a \$20,000 grant from the City of Swan to continue our Foreshore Reserve Rehabilitation project. With the \$50,000 we received from the NRM late last year we will be able to complete the works in full within the next two years.

Our Carols in the Park event in December was another huge success with almost 500 people joining us for a terrific night. We have some fantastic events planned for this year as well as our tree planting days

and I urge you to enjoy and participate in the events planned.

We must keep reminding you of the importance of you all becoming members of the Association if you have not already joined. The number of members is often a contributing factor when applying for grant funding, requesting support from the City of Swan and liaising with other bodies. It makes communication with you easier so we can keep you up to date without having to roam the streets hand delivering information. We don't expect too much but the number of members makes a huge difference.

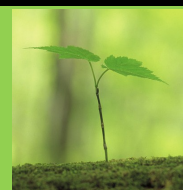
