Sunday July 27th


A huge THANK YOU to the 80 volunteers who gave up a few hours on Sunday 27 July to help plant nearly 10,000 seedlings. Volunteers received gloves, t-shirts, hats and a BBQ lunch on the day thanks to our sponsors. It was great day of tree planting that was enjoyed by everyone, even the two little showers didn't dampen spirits.

The day was a huge success thanks to the support of **Planetark** who through **Midland Toyota** provided a wonderful pack filled with gloves, shirts and hats; Midland Toyota who sponsored the BBQ supplies; **Masters** who kindly donated \$250 worth of buckets, gloves etc to be used on the day; **Stratton Lions Club** who kindly cooked the BBQ and fed all the wonderful volunteers on the day. Although many of the 80 volunteers were from Jane Brook it was fantastic to see people from surrounding and far away suburbs help to make the Jane Brook Foreshore a beautiful place for wildlife and people to use.

This planting saw the JBCA use the last of our \$50,000 NRM grant from 2013 to purchase the seedlings. We have now successfully planted over 100,000 seedlings along the Jane Brook Foreshore in the last three years. This would not have been possible without the NRM grant or the \$20,000 matching grant last year from the City of Swan.

The President of the JBCA, Mathew Merson, is extremely passionate about the Jane Brook Foreshore and its regeneration and without his drive and enthusiasm this three year program would not have become a reality. Thank you Mathew!

RECIPE OF THE MONTH "September"

Pumpkin, Broccoli and Bacon Pasta

INGREDIENTS

- ◆ 1 tablespoon extra virgin olive oil
- ◆ 1 red onion, halved, sliced
- ◆ 6 shortcut bacon rashers, trimmed, chopped
- ◆ 500g butternut pumpkin, peeled, cut into 2cm cubes
- ◆ 2 garlic cloves, thinly sliced
- ◆ 4 sprigs fresh thyme
- ◆ 1 cup chicken stock
- ◆ 250g dried spaghetti
- ◆ 1 head broccoli, cut into small florets
- ◆ 1/4 cup thickened cream
- ◆ Toasted pine nuts, fresh basil leaves and finely grated parmesan, to serve.

METHOD

Heat oil in a large heavy-based saucepan or flameproof casserole dish over medium-high heat. Add onion, bacon and pumpkin. Cook, stirring occasionally, for 5 minutes or until onion is softened. Add garlic and thyme. Stir to combine.

Add chicken stock and 2 cups cold water. Cover. Bring to the boil. Add spaghetti. Reduce heat to medium. Simmer, uncovered, for 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add broccoli. Simmer for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally, or until pasta and broccoli are tender and the sauce has thickened.

Remove from heat. Remove and discard the thyme sprigs. Stir in cream. Season with salt and pepper. Serve pasta sprinkled with pine nuts, basil leaves and parmesan.



UPDATE

Over the last few months the JBCA has worked towards the following achievements

A concrete bridge has been replaced in beautiful stone. The bridge at the end of Cupania Court has also been replaced.



Dongara Circle Park

Wire fencing replaced around the storm drainage inlet to the lake area. Concrete curbing to the garden beds has been replaced.

The planting of additional verge trees.

Sherlock Park

Installation of a wire fence on the Foreshore Reserve to keep out people and bikes in order to protect recent rehabilitation of the area.

Installation of two permanent fences on the Jane Brook Foreshore reserve to stop motorbikes. These will be painted in the coming few weeks.

Dorrigo Park

Approval has been granted and funds have been set aside for the replacement of the gazebo within the park. This will allow a larger area for under cover gatherings and events.



Rubbish collection by members throughout the suburb is continuing, most recently with the Talbot Road litter collected.
