### RECIPE OF THE MONTH "APRIL" **CHEWY ANZAC BISCUITS**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

(1 cup (150g) plain flour

1 cup (90g) rolled oats

(4 cup (85g) desiccated coconut

3/4 cup (155g) brown sugar

125g butter

2 tbs golden syrup

1 tbs bicarbonate of soda

2 tbs water



# (METHOD

- Preheat the oven to 160°C. Line two baking trays with non-stick baking paper. Sift the flour into a large bowl. Stir in the oats, coconut and brown sugar.
- Put the butter, golden syrup and water in a small saucepan. Stir over a medium heat until melted. Stir in the bicarbonate of soda.
- Pour the butter mixture into the flour mixture and stir until combined. Roll level tablespoons of mixture into balls. Place on the trays about 5cm apart. Press with a fork to flatten slightly. Bake for 10 minutes or until golden brown.


Average Signal Strength Inside




