

Off-Road Vehicles

If you fancy taking your off-road vehicle (ORV) "off-road", take a trip out to the Gnangara Pine Plantation, Gnangara Road in Lexia. This is a designated area of dirt tracks where you can drive your vehicle, 4WD or motorbike

It is an <u>offence</u> to operate an ORV/trail bike at any other time or place within the City of Swan, including <u>JANE</u> BROOK.

Problems?

The misuse of off-road vehicles can cause a number of problems, including noise, damage to property and bushland and hazards if the vehicle is driven on public roads. Here are some useful contact numbers if your need to report a problem:

ORV/trail bikes and hoons on public roads, contact the police on 131 444;

To report ORV/trail bike offenders in off-road areas, contact the City of Swan on **9267 9267**.

Offences & Penalties

The Control of Vehicles (Off-road Areas) Act 1978 regulates and controls the activities of off-road vehicles. 6(2) Driving or use of vehicle in prohibited area \$200 7(2) Unregistered off-road vehicle \$200
